

Why should I save?

- To provide funds for emergency expenditures.
- To afford a home, education, investments, or other products that will help improve your lifetime standard of living.
- To gain peace of mind.

What membership benefits are available to me at no cost?

- An enrollment card.
- The *American Saver* newsletter, which will be mailed or e-mailed to you four times a year.
- A factsheet on different types of savings accounts.
- Free advice from a financial planner.

So what does all this cost me?
No money. Your only obligation is to develop a specific savings goal, select an account, and make a deposit in this account each month (or make a debt payment).

Who controls my savings account?
You do. You open the account in your name. We only advise and encourage.

Who is sponsoring this program?
America Saves is managed by the non-profit Consumer Federation of America and advised by nearly 50 national non-profit, government and business groups.
Dull Knife Saves outreach is advised by a local committee with representatives from schools, consumer and community groups, churches, social service organizations, tribal programs, and financial service providers.
